

## **PUBLIC NOTICE – Regarding Sewer Break**

Be advised that MESD has had a Major sewer break after the recent heavy rainfall events and high groundwater table. A sanitary sewer 24 inch force main and 42 inch gravity sewer are out of service. The CSO's [Combined Sewer Overflows](#) began at 9:00 A.M. Tuesday, May 9<sup>th</sup>, 2017.

The overflows are occurring at the Breman Avenue Venice pump station Latitude 38° 40' 06" North and Longitude 90° 14' 47" ( North of McKinley Bridge in Venice Illinois )

and at the Madison Pump Station Latitude 38° 40' 36" North and Longitude 90° 10' 45" ( North of the Merchants Bridge )

Unfortunately, the river and ground water elevations are too high to repair the sewer lines so by-passes to the river are anticipated to continue for the next few weeks.
